A local law to abolish the position of Village Justice DEPARTMENT OF STAR.

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Port Leyden as follows:

Section 1. Authority.

This local law is adopted pursuant to the authority granted by Section 3-301(2)(a) of the Village Law.

Section 2. Abolition of Office.

The office of Village Justice for the Village of Port Leyden, Lewis County, New York, is and shall be abolished upon the expiration of the current term of such office on December 31, 2022.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This local law is adopted subject to a permissive referendum, and shall take effect upon the expiration of the referendum period or, in the event a referendum is called, upon the affirmative vote of a majority of those voting in such referendum, and the subsequent filing of this local law with the Department of State.
